BREEDING CONTRACT 2017

Terms of agreement:

- Breeding fee is US \$1 400 + applicable taxes.
- Breeding fee includes:
 - stud fee : US \$900
 - non refundable reservation fee : US \$250
 - collection fee for the first collection : US \$250
- Total payment must be received (check, electronic transfer or Paypal) before shipping of semen.
- The owner of the mare is responsible for all shipping fees.
- **Ans** is available for breeding all 2017 season (March through September).
- It is preferred that the mare owner informs the seller about the planned dates of collection and shipping of semen as soon as possible. In any case, a 24 hour notification prior the day of insemination is required.
- Health condition of the mare (before, during and after gestation) is the buyer's responsibility. It is recommended to have a veterinarian evaluate the breeding condition of the mare prior to breeding and perform a uterine culture and cytology in order to identify any problem that would interfere with fertility. Any recommendation from the veterinarian relative to the mare's health before breeding, the follow up of the pregnancy and the post partum should be followed.
- The artificial insemination must be performed by a veterinarian familiar with the procedures concerning equine reproduction. An insemination certificate must be sent to the seller by the veterinarian.
- Regular collection days are Monday through Sunday. Take note that Federal Express does not offer any service on Saturdays and Sundays, special arrangements shall be made if necessary.
- The seller agrees to supply and ship fresh quality semen the same day of collection to the address given by the buyer.
- An ultrasound should be performed 15 days (confirmation) and 30-35 days (single embryo confirmation) after insemination by an equine veterinary.
- In the case of nonpregnancy confirmation at 15th day ultrasound, the owner of the mare must provide to the seller a veterinary certificate of insemination, of ultrasound and of the mare health and breeding soundness (culture and cytology). The seller will then provide the buyer with one additional dose of cooled semen the same year or the following year (and the following year only), for which the buyer will only have to pay collection fee and shipping fees.

- In the case of a second nonpregnancy confirmation at 15th day ultrasound, the seller will provide the buyer with one last dose of cooled semen with the same conditions stated at previous point, the same year or the following year (and the following year only), for which the buyer will only have to pay collection fee and shipping fees. This third and last dose may be used to inseminate a different mare than stated on the contract, with the approbation of the seller.
- This contract includes a live foal guarantee, defined as such: newborn foal able to stand and nurse without assistance 24 hours after birth. In the event that the live foal guarantee would be used, the buyer may, in the following year only, return to breeding for the same mare (described in this contract) and pay the reservation fee, collection fee and shipping fees only. In the case cooled semen would no longer be available, the seller agrees to supply the buyer with one dose of frozen semen, in which case the buyer would only pay shipping fees and handling fees (payable to Centre de reproduction Transbio).
- In the case of abortion or death of the foal, the owner of the mare must provide to the seller a veterinary certificate, within three days and via registered mail, declaring the date, nature and cause of abortion or death. The buyer must also provide proof of examination of the mare's health and breeding soundness, of appropriate pregnancy follow up, as well as insemination certificate and performed ultrasounds.
- Any change to this contract (buyer, mare, etc.) must be agreed upon by both parties.
- A breeding certificate will be issued and sent to the buyer upon notification of the birth of the foal.
- A copy of the registration papers as well as a picture of the mare must be sent to the stallion's owner along with the signed agreement.
- This contract is a two year contract.
- The owner of the stallion is in no case responsible for any trouble related to shipping (loss of package, loss of semen viability); insurance on shipping is highly recommended.
- This contract is not transferable by neither of the parties.
