Terms of agreement:

- Total breeding fee is 1 800 USD.
- Breeding fee includes:

o stud fee: 1250 USD

non refundable reservation fee: 250 USD
 collection and preparation fee: 300 USD

- Total payment must be received (check or electronic transfer) before shipping of semen.
- A 45 USD fee will also be charged for the shipping box.
- The owner of the mare is responsible for all shipping fees.
- Lord Ans is available for breeding all through 2023 season (March through September).
- It is preferred that the mare owner informs the seller about the planned dates of collection and shipping of semen as soon as possible. In any case, a 24-hour notification prior the day of insemination is required. An additional fee of 75 USD will be charged for late notice (less than 24 hours) and, for staff availability reasons, collection might not be performed.
- Health condition of the mare (before, during and after gestation) is the buyer's responsibility. It
 is recommended to have a veterinarian evaluate the breeding condition of the mare prior to
 breeding and perform a uterine culture and cytology in order to identify any problem that would
 interfere with fertility. Any recommendation from the veterinarian relative to the mare's health
 before breeding, the follow up of the pregnancy and the post partum should be followed.
- The artificial insemination must be performed by a veterinarian familiar with the procedures concerning equine reproduction. A Breeding report will be included in the shipping box; the "Insemination" section must be signed by the veterinarian and transmitted to the seller.
- Regular collection days are Monday through Friday, before 9 am Eastern Time. Collection can be performed over the weekend, with prior verification as to technicians' availability, and a 75 USD fee will be added to the collection fees. Take note that Federal Express does not offer any service on Saturdays and Sundays, special arrangements shall be made if necessary. The buyer is responsible for making sure that Federal Express does deliver on Saturday in her or his area, should the collection happen on a Friday.
- The seller agrees to supply and ship fresh quality semen within 48 hours of collection to the address given by the buyer.
- An ultrasound should be performed 15 days (confirmation) and 30-35 days (single embryo confirmation) after insemination by an equine veterinary. The appropriate section "Pregnancy record" of the Breeding report should be filled-in and signed by the veterinarian.
- In the case of nonpregnancy confirmation at 15th day ultrasound, the owner of the mare must provide to the seller the signed "Breeding soundness", "Insemination" and "Pregnancy record" sections of the Breeding report. The seller will then provide the buyer with one additional dose of cooled semen the same year or the following year (and the following year only), for which the buyer will only have to pay collection fee and shipping fees.

- In the case of a second nonpregnancy confirmation at 15th day ultrasound, the seller will provide the buyer with one last dose of cooled semen with the same conditions stated at previous point, the same year or the following year (and the following year only), for which the buyer will only have to pay collection fee and shipping fees. *The buyer will have to perform and provide the seller with acceptable results of uterine cytology and culture for further doses to be sent under the same conditions.
- This contract includes a live foal guarantee (LFG), defined as such: newborn foal able to stand and nurse without assistance. In the event that the live foal guarantee would be used, the buyer may, in the following year only, return to breeding for the same mare (described in this contract) and pay the reservation fee, collection fee and shipping fees only.
- No reimbursement will be issued to buyer, except if stallion would become unfit for collection <u>prior</u> to mare's first insemination.
- In order to benefit from the live foal guarantee, the owner of the mare must provide to the seller: a veterinary certificate, within three days and via registered mail, declaring the date, nature and cause of abortion or death, as well as proof of examination of the mare's health and breeding soundness, of appropriate pregnancy follow up, as well as insemination certificate and performed ultrasounds. The thoroughly filled-in and signed Breeding report is equivalent and can be sent in with the same conditions (within three days and via registered mail).
- A breeding certificate will be issued upon request and sent to the buyer upon notification of the birth of the foal. Buyer is responsible for compliance with registry requirements and payment of any fees for the subsequent registration of foals conceived.
- A copy of the registration papers as well as a picture of the mare must be sent to the stallion's owner along with the signed agreement.
- This contract is a two year contract
- The owner of the stallion is in no case responsible for any trouble relater to shipping (loss of package, loss of semen viability); insurance on shipping is highly recommended.
- It is also the buyer's responsibility to make sure all importation requirements are met. Seller is not responsible for any custom caused delays.
- Any change to this contract (buyer, mare, etc.) must be agreed upon by both parties.
- This contract is not transferable by neither of the parties.
